

Eileen Tallman Memorial Scholarship Award

This \$1000 award will be given annually at the South Jersey Interscholastic Swimming Association banquet to a senior boy or girl who has been an active participant of the high school swim team for at least two years.

The candidate will have a minimum “B” academic average, exhibit sportsmanship and leadership qualities and demonstrate a financial need.

The student athlete will submit a one page essay on “How Swimming Has Impacted My Life”.

In the attached personal statement, discuss any special circumstances that contribute to your need for financial support for college, and explain why you would be a worthy recipient of this scholarship.

The coach is required to write a short statement explaining why the swimmer is deserving of this award along with emphasizing his/her degree of need. Each coach may nominate (1) swimmer from his/her team/teams.

The committee will make its selection solely on the facts and statements as they relate to the criteria for the award.

Please respond to the questions below, keeping in mind that the level of care and effort your responses demonstrate will be one of the criteria used by the scholarship committee in selecting scholarship recipients.
