

OK, you found your way here to find out how to earn a maximum of 9 bonus points toward the total points you accumulate that determine your grade each marking period.....

1) Find an **INTERACTIVE webpage** that is related to either our current topic of study in your class or the most recent past topic that we covered in your class, NOT A FUTURE TOPIC.

When I say INTERACTIVE, it means it has an activity that requires its user to make choices or answer questions that lead to a better understanding of the science concepts it is related to.

(Just because a webpage has animation or a video doesn't mean it is interactive.)

2) Email me the link (or URL) for the webpage and be sure to also include a) a photo or screen capture that shows me you actually completed the interactive activity yourself and b) a brief summary of the concepts the activity covers that are current or were recently discussed in your class.

3) For each quality link to an interactive that you send me that is accompanied by a photo/screenshot and summary, I will confirm by email at the end of each MP that you were awarded 3 bonus points for the current, closing marking period.

You can send me no more than 3 links each marking period for the maximum of 9 bonus points mentioned above.

If an interactive you send to me is particularly good and I end up using the activity in class for any purpose, I will award you an additional 2 bonus points that can get you above the 9 point ceiling.
